

Permission to keep bees on a property

The Bee Removers Association of South Africa (BRASA) requires that all members obtain written permission from property owners to keep bees on their land. As members of BRASA, _____ trading as _____ upholds this requirement with the agreement below.

This agreement allows for the following:

1. The land owner gives their consent to eGenie to keep bees at the specified property below. The land owner can revoke this permission by email or written notice at any time and must allow eGenie reasonable opportunity to collect all bees, bee hives and equipment.
2. _____ will comply with all laws and regulations in placing the bee hives.
3. _____ will take reasonable steps to ensure that the bee hives do not cause nuisance, danger or annoyance to people, animals, or any activity within the vicinity of the bee hives.
4. _____ will hold public liability insurance of not less than R 1 000 000 for the time that the bee hives are kept at the specified location.
5. The land owner will inform all necessary people of the presence of the bee hives to ensure that the bee hives are not disturbed.
